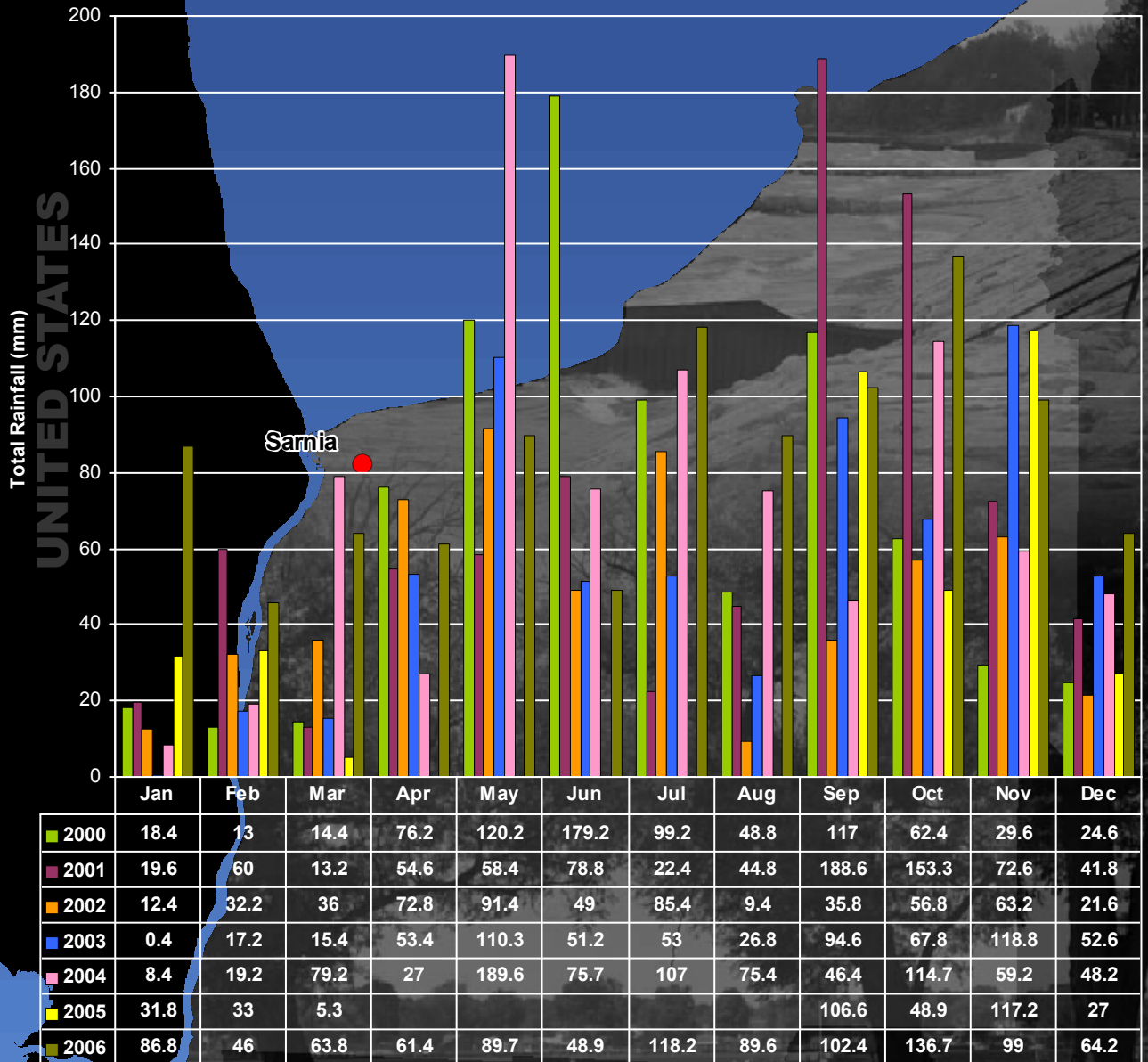


Map of LAMBTON COUNTY
